- x. The National Examination Council of Tanzania (NECTA) should verify certificates from foreign examination bodies for Ordinary or Advanced level education.
- xi. The Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU) and National Council for Technical Education (NACTE) should verify certificates from foreign Universities and other training institutions;
- xii. Certificates from foreign Universities should bare a GPA calculated (out of five (5) grade points) by Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU).
- xiii. A signed application letter should be written either in Swahili or English and Addressed to ***Vice Chancellor, University of Dodoma (UDOM), and P.O. Box 259, Dodoma.***
- xiv. Deadline for application is 25th June, 2025;
- xv. Only shortlisted candidates will be informed on the date of interview and;
- xvi. Presentation of forged certificates and other information will necessitate to legal action;
