- Technology Transfer and Extension Services: To act as a link between agricultural research
  institutions and farmers. They translate scientific findings into practical, actionable advice,
  conduct field trials and demonstrations, and organize training sessions, workshops, and farmer
  field days to disseminate knowledge on modern farming practices and technologies together
  with promoting MAC products and services.
