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Position Summary

IHI seeks a qualified **Research nurse /assistant nursing officer** who will work at antenatal care clinics and collect data on mothers and infants enrolled in the MMS-MAP study. She/he will play an essential role in data collection for the trial and ensure optimal care is provided for the participants.

Duties and Responsibilities

- To participate in clinical research study as per research protocol, GCP, SOPs etc.
- To ensure protection, rights, safety, and well – being of the study participant.
- S/he will be responsible for participant's recruitment.
- To conduct anthropometric measurements.
- Take blood and other specimens and serve as a liaison with the laboratory.
- To provide counseling on psychosocial and nutritional issues.
- To ensure the participants privacy and confidentiality are maintained.
- To ensure all study related forms are properly and accurately filled and data is entered daily according to the standard operating procedures (SOPs).
